

# Match Day

**Match your dollars with Foundation Funds to support your favorite local nonprofits!**

**Where:** The Frauenthal Theater lobby

**When:** Thursday, May 28, from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

The Community Foundation *for* Muskegon County (CFMC), with its Fund partners, is offering \$35,000 (and growing) in “match” money. Individual community donors, giving generously to their favorite qualifying Muskegon organizations, will have their donations matched by the Foundation’s Funds. Join the Foundation and your favorite nonprofits for a day of festive activities and philanthropy.

## **Match Day Details and Guidelines**

1. Donations by cash, check, or credit card shall be presented to the Community Foundation in the lobby of the Frauenthal Theater on Match Day to be time-stamped. We are unable to accept donations for Match Day online, by phone, or by mail due to the extra cost/time involved.
2. Donations will be matched at a minimum of \$0.50 to the dollar, up to \$1,000 per donor (\$2,000 donation = \$1,000 match). Donors may certainly give more, but only \$1,000 can be matched. If the pool of match dollars becomes large enough, it may become a dollar to dollar match.
3. Checks should be made payable to CFMC with the name of the qualifying nonprofit in the memo line of the check.
4. Qualifying nonprofit organization are those with an endowment fund at CFMC. You will find the list of qualifying organizations on our website at [www.cffmc.org](http://www.cffmc.org). Donations are to be used to further the mission of the organizations and not for any capital campaign projects or endowment building.
5. For donations to multiple nonprofits, a form is available to accompany your donation which lists the eligible organizations and an amount you would like to designate for each. The form is available the CFMC website, in our office, and in the Frauenthal Theater lobby.
6. All donations and match dollars will be “passed through” the Community Foundation directly to the qualifying nonprofit. No fees will be deducted by the Foundation.
7. No single nonprofit shall receive more than 10% of the match dollars, BUT, a separate \$1,000 prize will be awarded to the nonprofit that receives the greatest number of donations.
8. Nonprofits will be given their “Match Day” checks at the CFMC annual lunch, June 24<sup>th</sup>. Stay tuned for event details...
